RFP/RFQ Evaluation Report

The Mississippi Department of Mental Health's (MS DMH) Bureau of Intellectual and Developmental Disability (IDD) Services conducted a Request for Proposal (RFP) solicitation to secure a vendor to provide IDD Crisis Training. The RFP, including terms, conditions, scope of services and other maters anticipated to be incorporated into the resulting contract, may be accessed at https://www.dmh.ms.gov/news/rfp/.

With the goal of awarding a three-year contract to include a one-year optional renewal, MS DMH adhered to the applicable provisions of the *Public Procurement Review Board, Office of Personal Service Contract Review Rules and Regulations*, as well as agency guidelines, to evaluate the one proposal received to ensure they received a comprehensive, fair, and impartial evaluation. An internal evaluation committee utilized consensus scoring to evaluate the proposal using a two-step process consisting of Compliance and Analysis phases. A detailed description of the evaluation process is provided in Section C of Attachment A included within the RFP document. Evaluation factors and their respective weighing included Management at 40%, Cost at 35%, and Technical at 25%.

As a result of the evaluation process described herein, the proposals are ranked by vendor in order of final score, highest to lowest, as follows:

1. The Arc of Mississippi

Attached is the Summary Evaluation Score Sheet. The evaluation committee was comprised of the following individuals based on their knowledge and expertise related to the services being solicited: Craig Kittrell, Deputy Director of MS DMH IDD Services, Dr. Kristin Merritte, Chief Clinical Officer, Bureau of IDD Services, and Jerry Lewis, Division Director for ID/IDD Transition Services and Community Care.

Based on the evaluation results, the MS DMH will enter into contract negotiations with **The Arc of Mississippi** to provide **IDD Crisis Training**. Subject to successful negotiations and final approval by the Public Procurement Review Board, a three-year contract to include a one-year optional renewal, is expected to be executed with **The Arc of Mississippi**, with services to commence effective **July 15**, **2024**, at a contract value estimated not to exceed approximately \$1,356,000.00 for a three-year term with option to renew for one additional year.
