## MINUTES STATE BOARD OF MENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH JACKSON, MS THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2024

The Mississippi State Board of Mental Health held their regularly scheduled board meeting on Thursday, October 17, 2024, at East Mississippi State Hospital in Meridian, MS.

The meeting was called to order at 9 a.m. by Dr. Alyssa Killebrew with a roll call of the board members. Dr. Killebrew asked everyone to stand while David Chandler opened the meeting with the invocation and Chief Skok led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dr. Killebrew asked for a motion and a second to approve the consent agenda. On the motion of Dr. Sara Gleason and a second by Dr. Alyssa Killebrew, the Board voted unanimously to approve the consent agenda. Dr. Killebrew requested Ms. Wendy Bailey, Executive Director, continue the meeting with her report.

Ms. Bailey provided an overview of the FY2024 Impact Report, which DMH has published for the first time this year. Unlike the detailed strategic plan, the Impact Report serves as a snapshot of the services and supports' impact across the state. Its purpose is to highlight how outcomes and access to care are improving, while also identifying areas that require ongoing attention. This report will be shared with the Governor and Lt. Governor later this month during meetings focused on discussing the state's challenges and future opportunities.

Ms. Bailey provided an overview of the FY2024 Adult Services Mental Health Data Report, which highlights statewide data related to adult mental health services. It includes the number of commitments by county, the counties with the highest rates of jail placements prior to admission to state hospitals and breaks down the data further by county and average wait time in jail.

Ms. Bailey also presented the FY2024 Audit and Fidelity Report. This report consists of two key components: the results of utilization review audits and the outcomes of fidelity reviews.

Ms. Bailey updated the board on the FY2026 Budget Request, which was submitted in September. The request includes a \$21.7 million increase in General Funds over FY2025. Following the submission, DMH learned that the Division of Medicaid plans to implement a rate increase for IDD services in July 2025, which will significantly impact the funding required for the operation of the ID/DD Home and Community-Based Waiver in FY2026. As a result, the funding request is expected to increase by an additional \$6 million.

Ms. Bailey also shared that the Governor showed support for DMH's suicide prevention awareness efforts and International Overdose Awareness Day in September, signing proclamations for both initiatives.

In conclusion, Ms. Bailey reported that DMH was invited to present before the Women, Children, and Families Study Group on October 3. The discussion focused on mental health and substance use services and supports in the state, and Ms. Bailey included the presentation in the board packet for review.

Dr. Killebrew indicated that Agenda Item IV, "Other Reports," included the Consolidated Financial Summary Report for the period ending September 30, 2024, as well as the Contract

Summary Report. She then asked Mr. Kelly Breland, Chief Financial Officer, to present the reports.

Mr. Breland presented the Consolidated Financial Summary for the eleven months ending September 30, 2024, highlighting several key areas of note in the financial summary.

Additionally, Mr. Breland presented the contract details for non-state retirees earning \$75,000 or more annually and state retirees earning \$20,000 or more annually.

Mr. Adam Moore presented the FY2024 Strategic Plan End-of-Year Report. Mr. Moore highlighted several key points from the Strategic Plan Dashboard and noted that the full report was included in the board packet for review.

Dr. Killebrew thanked Dr. Charles Carlisle for hosting the board meeting and invited him to present the Programming and Recreation Services update. Dr. Carlisle provided a brief update on the current Programming and Recreation Services at East Mississippi State Hospital. He concluded by expressing his gratitude to Mr. Robert Landrum for his years of dedicated service to the Board of Mental Health.

Dr. Edith Hayles shared that Judge Mills contacted her with a special request for North Mississippi Regional Center to name a road or building in honor of Edwin Jerry Wilburn, who served in the Mississippi House of Representatives from 1964 to 1987. Representative Wilburn was instrumental in introducing the bill to create a North Mississippi Regional Center.

Dr. Hayles requested permission to name a road after Representative Wilburn and to hold a special recognition event in the Spring of 2025. On the motion made by Dr. Herzog and seconded by Dr. Manda Griffin, the Board voted unanimously to name a road or building in honor of Edwin Jerry Wilburn.

## Patient Care Subcommittee Report

Dr. Duncan Stone reported the Patient Care Subcommittee met prior to the Board meeting. The Patient Care Subcommittee recommended the following medical appointments below:

On the motion of Dr. James Herzog and a second by Ms. Teresa Mosley, the Board unanimously approved Patient Care appointments.

Dr. Stone presented the Patient Care subcommittee bylaws. On motion of Dr. James Herzog and a second by Ms. Teresa Mosley, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Patient Care subcommittee bylaws.

Ms. Cyndi Eubank, Chief General Counsel gave the property report. Ms. Eubank reported that the City of Pearl has approached Mississippi State Hospital (MSH) seeking to modify the easement that the Board approved during the April 20, 2023, meeting.

The City of Pearl and Pickering Engineering informed MSH the easement needs to be modified slightly because the railroad (CPKCR) required them to move the sewer crossing further west to satisfy one of their engineering requirements for crossings near switches. Plat 1 (south of the railroad tracks) perpetual easement decreased from 0.36 to 0.34 acres, and temporary easement decreased from 0.48 to 0.45 acres. Plat 2 (north of the railroad tracks) perpetual easement increased from 0.38 to 0.40 acres, and temporary easement increased from 0.50 to 0.52 acres.

Mississippi State Hospital recommends that the Board of Mental Health grant this modification to the easement to the City of Pearl. MSH continues to work with Pickering Engineering and Bruce Stephens, Executive Director of the West Rankin Utility Authority, to improve MSH sewer lines. The property report was approved by the motion made by Dr. Sarah Gleason, and a second made by Dr. Manda Griffin.

Ms. Teresa Mosley shared that the Strategic Planning subcommittee met prior to the board meeting to review the End-of-Year Report.

Ms. Wendy Bailey conveyed the gratitude and appreciation expressed by both the Department of Mental Health and the Governor's Office for Mr. Landrum's 30+ years of dedicated service to the citizens of Mississippi. As a token of gratitude, a commendation from the Governor and resolution by the Board of Mental Health were presented to Mr. Landrum in recognition of his service to the people of the state.

Dr. Killebrew informed everyone there was no need for an executive session.

With no further business, on the motion of Dr. James Herzog and a second by Mr. Robert Landrum, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting.
